

## **Tiffany Skogstrom Boston Safe Shops Project**

Tiffany Skogstrom is the Project Coordinator at the Boston Public Health Commission's Safe Shops Project. Tiffany works with employees at automotive businesses that are overburdened with toxic chemicals, have little or no protection measures, and no health care. She works to deliver education and health care to this workforce, and get a commitment from auto shop managers to establish pollution prevention measures in the work place. Tiffany is a New England Regional Environmental Leadership Program Fellow, and has worked with Massachusetts Jobs with Justice in the call for universal health care and organized toxics campaigns for Health Care Without Harm. Previously, she worked with Clean Water Action, MassPIRG, and advocated for children as a caseworker in an adolescent group home.
