

## **Water9**

The WATER9 computer program is a tool that has been provided by EPA to facilitate environmental calculations. This course provides the basics of what the WATER9 program is and how it works, but just as importantly; it allows the participant to interact with the leader and ask questions during and after the training sessions. It also provides ideas as to how the participant can obtain additional instruction in the operation of WATER9. At the conclusion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Explain what WATER9 is and how it works
- Load a WATER9 project file and examine the calculations
- Change the project file and examine the effect of those changes
- Understand how to create WATER9 projects
- Learn to set up recycle flows of solids and water
- Learn to split the flow of wastewater among multiple units
- Learn how to model a batch process
