Accessibility by Car **From the North:**
Take I-5 South to Exit 167 (West Mercer Street/Fairview Avenue). Turn right onto Fairview Avenue, then take the first left onto Valley Street. Stay left as Valley Street merges into Broad Street. Continue on Broad Street to Elliott Avenue, and turn left. Once you pass the Wall Street intersection, park in the Art Institute of Seattle parking garage which is immediately on the right. Take the sky bridge to the Conference Center, World Trade Center Seattle, and Odyssey, the Maritime Discovery Center. The International Promenade is located in the Cruise Ship Terminal one block north of Bell Harbor on Alaskan Way. To access, follow the directions to Bell Harbor and take the elevator to the ground level.

From the South or Seattle-Tacoma International Airport:
Travel North on I-5 and take the Madison Street exit (also called Convention Place exit). Turn left onto Madison Street, and continue until you see the waterfront. Turn right onto Alaskan Way and pass Pier 66 on your left. After the sky bridge, turn right onto Wall Street, then turn right onto Elliott Avenue. Park in the Art Institute of Seattle parking garage on your immediate right. Take the sky bridge to the Conference Center, World Trade Center Seattle, and Odyssey, the Maritime Discovery Center. The International Promenade is located in the Cruise Ship Terminal one block north of Bell Harbor on Alaskan Way. To access, follow the directions to Bell Harbor and take the elevator to the ground level.

Airport Information

The Bell Harbor International Conference Center is approximately 14 miles, or 30 minutes (depending on traffic) from the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA).

Driving Directions:

Follow the directions listed in "Accessibility by Car" from the south.

Public Transportation:

From the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA), take the Metro Transit #194 bus inbound towards Downtown Seattle to the International District Station. Transfer to the westbound #99 bus (Waterfront via Pioneer Square) at South Jackson Street and 5th Avenue South. Exit the #99 bus at the Alaskan Way and Bell Street stop. The Bell Harbor International Conference Center is across the street. The bus fare is \$2.50, exact change.

Public Transportation

The Bell Harbor International Conference Center is accessible by transit, using King County's Metro Transit. The #99 bus runs along Alaskan Way, with a stop at the Center on the corner of Alaskan Way and Bell Street. The bus fare is \$1.75 (one- or two-zone, off-peak hours), \$2.00 (one-zone, peak hours), or \$2.50 (two-zone, peak hours) exact change.

Parking

Parking for the Bell Harbor International Conference Center is available at the Art Institute of Seattle parking garage on Elliott Avenue and Wall Street. The parking rate is \$8-16 per day, depending upon the size of the vehicle. Also, a limited number of on-street parking meters are available for \$2.50 per hour.

Onsite Registration

Registration will take place Thursday, May 21, 2009, beginning at 8:00 AM.
