AVAILABLE REBATES

WOODBURNING

- **\$500.** Replace an existing woodstove (12 years old or older) with a natural gas stove or
- **\$500.** Replace an existing fireplace insert (12 years old or older) with a natural gas fireplace insert

FIREPLACES

- **\$300.** Install a new gas fireplace insert into a pre-existing fireplace box or
- **\$300.** Retrofit an existing fireplace box with a new gas line and gas log set.*

* You must install a new gas line to apply for any of these rebates.

This is a first come - first served offer. Funding is limited. Retired woodstoves will be recycled by retailer.
