**Approval and Promulgation of Implementation Plans; Texas; Control of Emissions of  
Nitrogen Oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>) From Cement Kilns**

**AGENCY:** Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

**ACTION:** Proposed Approval.

**SUMMARY:** The EPA is proposing approval of revisions to the Texas State Implementation Plan (SIP). The State of Texas submitted this SIP revision to the 30 TAC Chapter 117 to us on June 15, 2007 (June 15, 2007 submittal) concerning control of emissions of NO<sub>x</sub> from cement kilns operating in Bexar, Comal, Ellis, Hays, and McLennan Counties of Texas. We are proposing to approve the cement kilns provisions of the June 15, 2007 submittal for cement kilns operating in these five Texas Counties. We are also proposing to approve the June 15, 2007 submittal as meeting the Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) requirements for NO<sub>x</sub> emissions from cement kilns operating in the Dallas Fort Worth (DFW) 8-hour ozone nonattainment area. The NO<sub>x</sub> emissions controls associated with this SIP revision will assist the DFW area to attain the Federal 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). We are proposing approval of this action as meeting Sections 110 and 182 of the Federal Clean Air Act (the Act).
