

Accessing ACRES after CDX Registration


This Quick Reference Guide (QRG) provides instructions for accessing ACRES once you have established your User Name and Password. All users will access ACRES through EPA's Central Data Exchange (CDX). The login process is described below.

1. Open your Internet browser to the following URL: <https://cdx.epa.gov>.

Note: ACRES is designed to operate with Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.5 or higher, and the user must disable any pop-up blockers that are running on the computer.

2. Enter the User Name and Password you set during the one-time CDX registration process. The User Name and Password fields are not case sensitive.

After entering both the User Name and Password, click "Login."

3. The MyCDX home page, as shown below, loads after a successful sign in. Click "[ACRES: Assessment Cleanup and Redevelopment Exchange](#)" to enter the application and load your ACRES Home screen.



After clicking “[ACRES: Assessment Cleanup and Redevelopment Exchange](#),” if your pop-up blocker prevents the application from loading, follow these steps:

1. Right click on the yellow message bar that indicates a pop-up has been blocked.
2. Highlight and left-click on “Always Allow Pop-ups from this Site.”
3. Click “Retry” from the dialog box to launch the application window.

The above three-step process will change the pop-up settings for only the CDX Web site.
