Question & Answers (updated 1/2/01)

Q: When is the NOCS and first Semiannual report due for Subpart PPP and are records for the first 150 days of operation included in the semiannual report?

A: For the Polyether Polyol Production NESHAP (40 CFR 63 subpart PPP), the Notification of Compliance Status (NOCS) is due 150 days after the compliance date(s). The first semiannual report is then due 240 days after the due date of the NOCS, and covers the 6-month period beginning on the due date of the NOCS. Subsequent semiannual reports are due every 6 months thereafter. Thus, records for operating during the 150 days following the compliance date are not included in any of the required semiannual reports.
