SUMMARY: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency [EPA] is issuing five-year Acid Rain permits, according to the Acid Rain Program regulations [40 CFR part 72], to the following 7 utility plants: Breed, Cayuga, Gibson, R Gallagher, and Wabash River in Indiana; B L England in New Jersey; and Muskingum River in Ohio.
